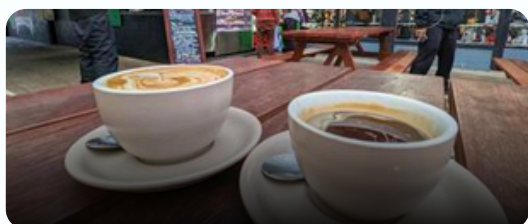

If you're visiting on the right day, explore an impressive collection celebrating Australia's motoring history.

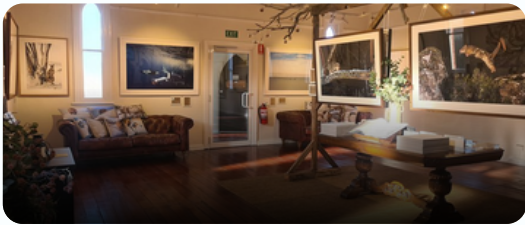

Browse the Jindabyne Art Gallery, Design and Detail, High Country Outfitters and Alpine Apothecary. Perfect for finding something special to take home.

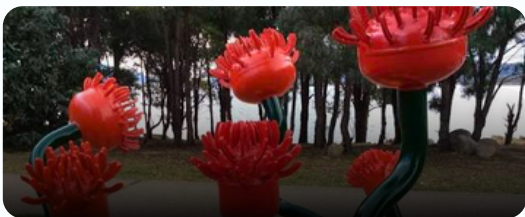
