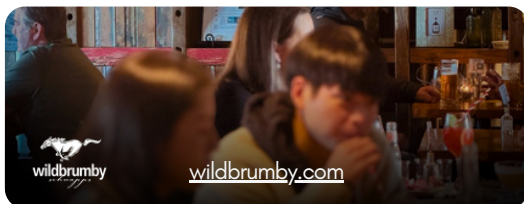
BREAKFAST AT PARC CAFÉ

GOURMET PICNIC ADVENTURE

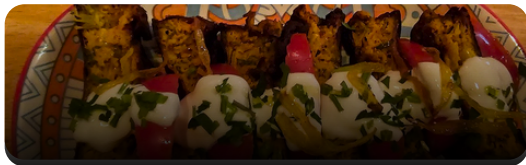
